Activity Report 2025

Within the framework of the ANBI status, we publish an annual report on the most important activities. These activities are presented in this report.

Activities

Repairs at the Wheelchair Repair Center

At the Wheelchair Repair Center, we provide walkers, crutches, wheelchairs, and medical beds to people with reduced mobility or those who have suffered an accident, after the equipment has been repaired and disinfected.

In 2025, 293 people temporarily benefited from a wheelchair, medical bed, walker, or underarm crutches as mobility support.



This support is made possible mainly thanks to donors from Romania, partly through contributions from beneficiaries who wish to give something back, and partly through other donors.

Mobile Workshop

Through the Mobile Workshop, we visited people with disabilities in their homes and assisted them with repairs to electric or standard beds, wheelchairs, walkers, and crutches. These devices and repairs are provided free of charge. This activity is made possible through the support of Joni & Friends Ministries.

In 2025, 252 people benefited from assistance with equipment repairs.

Special meetings were organized for people with disabilities in the towns of Câmpia Turzii and Oradea. In the city of Beclean, encouragement meetings and wheelchair repair activities took place during August, September, October, November, and December 2025. Many people also benefited from a warm meal following a substantial donation of food.

Mefiboset Center

Every month, meetings are organized for people with disabilities at the Mefiboset Center. Between 50 and 56 people from Cluj-Napoca and the surrounding areas participate and receive counseling or support for other social needs.

Aid Packages

Aid packages are distributed periodically to people with disabilities. In 2025, a total of 56 people with disabilities received Easter and Christmas gifts.

Camps for Families with Disabled Family Members

Every year, five-day recreational camps are organized for families that include people with disabilities. These camps are highly appreciated and have a special encouraging effect on those who are bedridden or use a wheelchair, as they rarely leave their homes except to participate in these camps.

In 2025, 74 people participated in these camps.

School Backpack and Supplies Project

In the autumn of 2025, the “School Backpack and Supplies” project for the 2025–2026 school year supported 23 children with special needs from disadvantaged families.

They received backpacks equipped with the necessary school supplies for the current school year.



Iosif Tosa and Ana Tosa felt a calling in their hearts to help the most disadvantaged social class — people who have no homes and live in huts covered with plastic tarpaulins. These families are extremely poor, have many children, and their only income comes from the state child allowance, while some also receive limited social assistance.

Support for Orphans

We provided monthly support and assistance for 14 orphans through a sponsorship program.
